## Arriving for first time in the U.S. January 2010

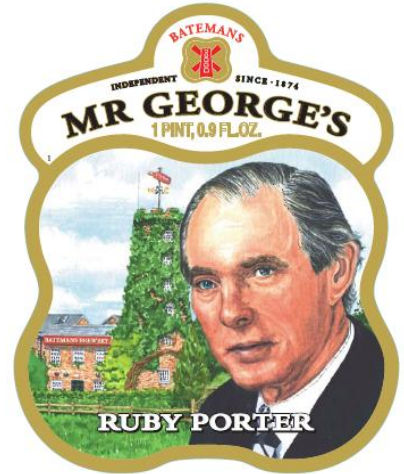
Black color with ruby-red hints. A full tan head with roasted grain notes and a hint of citrus and dark fruits to the nose. Roasted notes dominate the palate but are balanced by peppery hops and underlying tart fruit. A long finish that includes dark malt, licorice and coffee. Full-flavored and complex without being heavy.

Sold outside of the USA as Batemans Dark Lord. The USA version is an homage to George Bateman, brewery patriarch who passed away in 2007. "Mr. George" anxiously anticipated his brewery's return to the USA and this label honors the fulfillment of that vision.

Triple XB (XXXB) Classic Pale Ale  
 90 Points - Gold Medal

Deep brilliant copper color with a layered taupe head. Mild aromas of dried cherries and peaches, dusty roasted nuts, toffee follow through on a supple frothy entry to a dryish medium body with nutskin, slate, and mineral notes. Finishes with a crisp, refreshing and balanced fade.

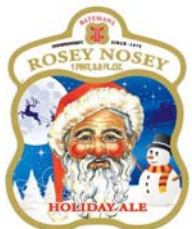

Combined Harvest Multigrain Beer  
 91 Points - Gold Medal

Brilliant pale amber color with a lacy head. Aromas of buttered multigrain toast and orange marmalade follow through on a soft, round entry to a crisp, dryish medium-to-full body with lively citrus acidity and walnut praline notes. Finishes with a tangy, palate stimulating fade of cocoa, nuts and mild citrusy hops. A superb food beer.

Rosey Nosey Holiday Ale (Winter Seasonal)

"A rich, luscious and warming ale ideal for winter and the Christmas period, brewed by the family-owned Bateman's brewery in Wainfleet, Lincolnshire. It is made from Maris Otter pale and crystal malts and wheat malt and English Goldings hops. The aroma is ripe with sultana and raisin fruit, balanced by biscuity malt and tangy hop resins. Sappy malt, burnt fruit and spicy hops dominate the palate while the long and complex finish has vine fruits, intensely bitter hops and rich malt."
